- Services are also available in Spanish.

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

There is hope for pancreatic cancer patients and it starts with knowing your options. The PANCREATIC CANCER ACTION NETWORK'S Patient and Liaison Services (PALS) program is available to provide comprehensive and free call-in services to pancreatic cancer patients, their families and medical teams.

A CARING SOURCE OF RELIABLE INFORMATION AND SUPPORT

When you call PALS, you will establish a one-on-one connection with a dedicated PALS Associate. Your PALS Associate can provide you with the most current information about the disease, treatment options, clinical trials, specialists, support groups, diet and nutrition, symptom and pain management, and much more.

Contact your PALS Associate as many times as necessary to get all the information you need throughout your journey. You will speak to the same person each time you call, so you can continue the conversation. The information you share with your PALS Associate is private and confidential.

LEARN ABOUT THE LATEST CLINICAL TRIALS

The Pancreatic Cancer Action Network recommends that all patients consider clinical trials when exploring treatment options. It is vital to receive accurate and current information about clinical trials before making other treatment decisions. PALS maintains a comprehensive database containing up-to-date information about all pancreatic cancer clinical trials taking place in the United States.

Simplify the process. Your PALS Associate can perform a customized search of the database. You can then take your personalized results to your doctor to discuss all of your treatment options.

GET SUPPORT FROM OTHERS

Talk to someone who has been through it. Your PALS Associate can match you with volunteers in the Survivor and Caregiver Network. You can connect by phone or email to share experiences, ask questions and get support.

GET THE KNOWLEDGE YOU NEED

The PALS library offers educational booklets and fact sheets on more than 55 topics related to pancreatic cancer. All materials are reviewed for accuracy by scientific and medical experts in pancreatic cancer – and all are available free of charge. PALS also provides the Pancreatic Cancer Educational Event Series of programs for patients, families and healthcare professionals in cities throughout the United States.
